What is social work?

- ◆ Social work is a profession concerned with helping individuals, families, groups and communities to enhance their well-being.
- ◆ Social work aims to help people develop their skills and their ability to use their own resources and those of the community to resolve problems.
- ◆ Social work is concerned with individual and personal problems but also with broader social issues such as stigma, poverty, unemployment and domestic violence.



What do social workers do?

At Providence Care's Mental Health Services site social workers provide a wide range of services both in the hospital and the community for severe and persistent mental health problems such as depression, anxiety, bipolar disorders, schizophrenia, personality disorders, and dementia. Social workers provide:

- ◆ psychosocial assessment
- ◆ counselling/psychotherapy for individuals, couples, families and groups
- ◆ individual/family/group psychoeducation
- ◆ case management
- ◆ discharge planning (includes help obtaining financial support, housing, community referrals)
- ◆ supervision, teaching & research
- ◆ consultation
- ◆ community capacity building
- ◆ social action

How can I talk to a social worker?

Most of the health care teams at Mental Health Services have a social worker. Ask your doctor or any member on the team to speak to yours.

Are there standards of practice for social work?

- ◆ The Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers regulates social work practice in Ontario. All Mental Health Services social workers are registered with the College and possess a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Social Work.
- ◆ All social workers at Mental Health Services have agreed to follow the Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice of the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers.
