

Providence Manor

Providence Care's Providence Manor is a 243-bed long-term care facility that provides a range of services and activities in a home-like environment. There is a specialized Alzheimer's Unit for residents who are at risk of wandering due to dementia as well as several community programs. The grounds contain a secure outdoor courtyard with a pathway, fountain and landscaped garden.

Respite Care

Short-term stays are available for elderly people who are normally cared for at home, providing temporary relief for their caregivers. The seniors in respite care also benefit from Providence Manor's programs and services.

Hildegarde Day Centre and Day Away Program

These programs are designed for frail seniors living in the community. Participants with cognitive or physical impairments participate in stimulating activities to help achieve high levels of independence. The Hildegarde Centre provides recreational, physical, social and spiritual activities as well as personal care and nutrition services. The Day Away Program takes a similar approach, but is designed for those with Alzheimer's disease. Both programs also provide respite for those caring for elderly relatives.

Attendant Care Outreach Program

This innovative program allows people with physical disabilities to live independently in their own home. Attendants provide homemaking and personal support services.

Endymion Program

Part of the Attendant Care Outreach Program, Endymion is a supportive living program for those who require 24-hour access to attendant services. Endymion clients live independently in 10 fully accessible apartments within a large Kingston apartment complex.
