

Volunteer Opportunities at Mental Health Services:

Dual Diagnosis Center: This center is for people with a dual diagnosis: an intellectual disability or autism or pervasive developmental disorder, with a suspected or diagnosed mental illness and/or behavioral disorder. Volunteers are needed to assist with activities in the center such as Social Skills, Sign Language and Stretch, Drama, Music/Choir and open activity time.

Friendship Villa: This is a drop in style library for clients with books, magazines, a computer and a television. Volunteers are needed to open the library and while there, read with clients, play games, serve juice, do crafts, discuss current events and many other activities.

Gift Shop: Volunteers are needed to work in the Gifts N' Things gift shop.

Recreation: Volunteers are needed to assist in a variety of different recreation programs, which are run on a daily basis. This can include games, music, crafts, creative story telling, special events etc.

Spiritual Care: There are a number of worship services offered for clients each week. Volunteers are needed to porter clients to the chapel as well as help them participate in the service.

Westwood School: At this school, clients are able to complete education that they may not have been able to in the community. They also run many daily fun activities. Volunteers are needed to work one-on-one with clients.
